Remember When: Mad Magazine

There was a time when teens and young adults couldn't wait to get their hands on an issue of Mad Magazine, the publication that aimed to "make fun of anything and everything." Launched as a comic book in 1952, lampooning popular characters of the era such as Superman and Archie, Mad made the switch to a magazine format in 1955. Soon after, its new mascot, a goofy grinning kid named Alfred E. Neuman, began appearing on the cover of many issues. Among Mad's many beloved recurring features were "Spy vs. Spy," "The Lighter Side of ... " and the Fold-In, located on the inside back cover, that could be creased to create a new picture. Paving the way for other films, TV shows and publications that spoofed news headlines and pop culture, Mad Magazine stopped producing new material in 2019.
